#### **New Beginnings.**

This has been a major theme across the 2022 year at Summit Grove. As I'm writing this, the bulldozers are rumbling around as water pipes are being laid (hurray for strong infrastructure!) and dying trees are being pulled down -- making way for new trees being planted this Spring. The maintenance pole barn construction will be complete by the end of March, and our 15 brand new RV sites will be ready for visitors by late Spring. The Youth Barn now has water access, and the blueprints are being completed this month to add a kitchen and bathroom to it. It's all very exciting!

Throughout this past year, we were able to connect with 17 local churches who hosted their church services throughout the summer here for Summit Grove Sundays. We saw over 400 children spend their week enjoying the outdoors and growing in their faith during the 10 weeks of summer camp. Dozens of church retreat groups, youth conferences, worship events, and community gatherings were held here, in alignment with our mission to "create space for people to encounter God, connect with others, and enjoy life."

One of my favorite memories from 2022 was seeing dozens of individuals make the choice to become baptized, with sounds of erupting joy from those witnessing as they emerged from the water. My prayer for this year is that this land will be baptized once again under the Lord's glory and power, and that anything not intended to move forward into this next season of new beginnings would fall away.





# CAMP IMPROVEMENTS



#### Phase 1 / RV Site Update

Phase 1 renovations continue to go well. The water, sewer, and electric installs are about 80% complete! The construction crew is focused on outlining the RV sites, and getting them ready for curbing when the weather is warm enough. We are working on some blueprints for adding a kitchen area to the Youth Barn, a project which a church from North Carolina has graciously offered to lead for us! Construction is scheduled to start February 2023 on a Maintenance Pole Barn. which should be done by Spring 2023. We will also be planting 350 new small trees around the campground! Although the rain in Fall 2022 delayed this project timeline, the warmer weather during the winter is allowing the construction crew to still work consistently in order to bring our RV sites online, hopefully by May 2023!
