



DAY CAMP PARENT AGREEMENT 2020

I/we hereby enroll our child(ren) in Summit Grove's Summer Day Camp program with the following understanding:

ELIGIBILITY

Campers need to be going into kindergarten through eighth grade.

PROGRAM GOAL

Summit Grove partners with parents/guardians and the community in providing a unique summertime experience that will provide life-long benefits for each child.

CAMP STAFF

Camp staff abide by the beliefs and standards of conduct as set forth in the Summit Grove Mission and Vision Statement. Counselors are chosen based on their quality of character and desire to be leaders and mentors to children. All staff that have direct contact with campers will submit the appropriate clearances.

CHAPEL & DEVOTIONS

Campers will participate in daily devotions based on Biblical principles in small groups and attend chapel daily with all campers for a time of singing, announcements and review of devotional themes.

LUNCH & SNACKS

Lunch and two snacks are included in the price of tuition.

FOOD ALLERGIES

If your child has any food allergies, please feel free to contact Summit Grove's Director of Hospitality & Events, LeChae Stoneberg (lechae@summitgrovecamp.org) at the time of registration.

DAY CAMP RULES

Three rules sum up behavior expectations – obey counselors, be kind to others, be nice to things. These rules, as well as other specific expectations, will be clearly communicated to the campers.

DRESS CODE/SWIMMING ATTIRE

Campers are encouraged to wear comfortable clothing and shoes for outdoor play. Girls need one piece or tankini-style swim suits to adhere to the camp's modesty policy.

DISCIPLINE

The Day Camp Director, counselors and camp staff make and enforce camp regulations in a manner consistent with Christian principles (not to include corporal punishment). Reasonable restraint may be used when providing for immediate safety. SG reserves the right to dismiss any child who does not cooperate with the program's rules of conduct. Tuition will not be refunded for the weeks in which a student is dismissed.

ILLNESS

If your child experiences any of the following conditions, they should be kept at home until they have been symptom-free for 24 hours or are cleared by a physician: fever greater than 100 degrees Fahrenheit, upper respiratory tract infection, vomiting, diarrhea, conjunctivitis (pink eye), streptococcal pharyngitis (strep throat),

chicken pox, lice or scabies, impetigo or fungal skin infections. The Day Camp Director should be contacted if your child will be absent from camp due to illness.

OFF CAMPUS

On rare occasions, campers going into grades K-5 may take walking field trips with their counselors to the rail trail. Campers going into grades 6-8 may take walking field trips with their counselors.

REGISTRATION AND TUITION

To register, parents/guardians need to submit a completed registration form (including emergency information) and registration fee per camper. Summit Grove will verify registration and produce an invoice. Summit Grove will bill for all weeks marked on the registration form. All notices, invoices and statements will be emailed to the primary billing contact indicated on the registration form. No refunds will be given for missed days.

PAYMENTS

Payments are due the Wednesday before the camper attends. No camper may attend camp until the week is paid in full. Summit Grove will bill for all weeks marked on the registration form. Early payment is preferred and encouraged.

CHANGES TO REGISTRATION FORM

Changes are to be submitted to Summit Grove thru our Day Camp page on our website two weeks before the change is to occur. Use the Changes to Registration online form. Any changes to the registration form must be approved by the office. After two changes, a \$15 processing fee will be added for each additional change.

QUESTIONS OR CONCERNS

Billing questions should be directed to the office. Program questions should be directed to the Day Camp Director.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY

I/we agree to hold SG and its agents harmless for any liability to my child, or any guardian or parent thereof, because of any claims on behalf of my child against SG or any agent thereof because of any injury or alleged injury to my child(ren). Should legal action for any reason be taken against SG or any employee or agent not be found at fault, I agree to pay any attorney fees, court fees, damages or other costs that SG or its agent should incur to defend itself against such action.
