



SUMMER CAMP PARENT AGREEMENT 2019

I/we hereby enroll our child(ren) in Summit Grove's Summer Camp with the following understanding:

PROGRAM GOAL

Summit Grove Camp partners with parents/guardians and the community in providing a unique summertime experience that will provide life-long benefits for each child.

CAMP STAFF

Camp staff abide by the beliefs and standards of conduct as set forth in the Summit Grove Mission and Vision Statement. Counselors are chosen based on their quality of character and desire to be leaders and mentors to children.

CHAPEL/DEVOTIONS

Campers will attend chapel daily for a time of singing and learning from the Bible and/or meet for time of Bible-based devotions.

SUMMER CAMP RULES

Three rules sum up behavior expectations – obey staff, be kind to others, be nice to things. These rules, as well as other specific expectations, will be clearly communicated to the campers.

DRESS CODE/SWIMMING ATTIRE

Campers are encouraged to wear comfortable clothing and shoes for outdoor play. Girls need one piece or tankini-style swim suits to adhere to the camp's modesty policy.

DISCIPLINE

The Program Director and camp staff make and enforce camp regulations in a manner consistent with Christian principles (not to include corporal punishment). Reasonable restraint may be used when providing for immediate safety. SGC reserves the right to dismiss any child who does not cooperate with the program's rules of conduct. Tuition will not be refunded for the weeks in which a student is dismissed.

ILLNESS

If your child experiences any of the following conditions, they should be kept at home until they have been symptom-free **24 hours** or are cleared by a physician: fever greater than 100 degrees Fahrenheit, upper respiratory tract infection, vomiting, diarrhea, conjunctivitis (pink eye), streptococcal pharyngitis (strep throat), chicken pox, lice or scabies, impetigo or fungal skin infections. The Program Director should be contacted if your child will be absent from camp due to illness.

OFF CAMPUS

On rare occasions, campers may take walking field trips with camp staff to the rail trail or local destinations.

REGISTRATION AND TUITION

To register, parents/guardians need to submit a completed registration form, emergency contact form and camp tuition per camper. All notices, invoices and statements will be emailed to the primary billing contact indicated on the registration form. No refunds will be given for missed days. Fees are non-refundable if within 14 days of the camp.

CHANGES TO REGISTRATION FORM

Any changes to the registration form must be approved by the office. After two changes, a \$15 processing fee will be added for each additional change.

QUESTIONS OR CONCERNS

Billing and program questions should be directed to the Program Director.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY

I/we agree to hold SGC and its agents harmless for any liability to my child, or any guardian or parent thereof, because of any claims on behalf of my child against SGC or any agent thereof because of any injury or alleged injury to my child(ren). Should legal action for any reason be taken against SGC or any employee or agent not be found at fault, I agree to pay any attorney fees, court fees, damages or other costs that SGC or its agent should incur to defend itself against such action.
