## 2023 RV Site Policies

- Check-in is after 3 pm and check-out is before 11 am.
- Early check-in or late check-out must be arranged and approved by the office. Check-in at the camp office is not required. Provided you have paid in full, you may go directly to your site. All accounts should be paid in full prior to arrival unless other payment terms were made with the office.
- Quiet hours: 11 pm – 7 am. Please always be respectful of other guests. This is a family-friendly campground.
- Alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, firearms, and fireworks are prohibited anywhere on the grounds.
- Smoking is discouraged and is not permitted within 20 ft of any buildings or pavilions. Cigarette butts may not be left on the ground.
- Small pets are permitted if always kept quiet and on a leash. Please clean up after your pet.
- Sites may accommodate up to 7 people, including day guests.
- Max two vehicles per RV site, provided they stay parked on the gravel pad and do not block the main lane.
- Prior to departure, campsites should be cleaned, trash placed in dumpsters, and picnic tables returned to their proper location. Unused firewood can be returned to the woodshed by the RV bathhouse.
- Although guests should be out of their RV sites by checkout time, you are invited to stay and enjoy the grounds, provided they are not reserved by a private group.
- All fires must be built in the rings provided and always attended. Please make sure the fire is extinguished before retiring for the night.
- Golf carts are allowed only if they are electric. Gas-powered golf carts, ATVs, dirt bikes, and horses are not permitted on the property.
- The Activity Field and Barn (if not reserved for a private group) are common areas for all retreat guests. Please be courteous of other guests and clean up any space that you use by disposing of all trash and returning all games and equipment to their proper storage location. Please report any missing or broken equipment, items, or utilities. Please ensure the Barn doors stay closed at all times.
- Laundry facilities are available. You will find the door code available in your check-in email.
- Ice and other convenience items can be purchased at Rutter’s Gas Station (.5 miles, 10 min walk)
- Please report all maintenance needs to the office or to the camp host.
- For medical emergencies please call 911 and then notify the on-call staff or weekend host.
